

## Newsworthy Issue #3 - Week of February 19th, 2023

- An information session about the **New Emerging Professor Program (EPP)** was held, and over **150** students attended and expressed their interest in a future at KFUPM.
- Top university administrators concluded a visit to 5 universities in Malaysia and Singapore, most notably, the National University of Singapore, Nanyang Technological University, and Universiti Teknologi Petronas. The visit provided a wealth of knowledge, such as programs for non-academic student development and the alignment of research with government priorities.
- In order to boost employee engagement and departmental activities, all departments have been allocated **10,000 SAR**/semester to be used towards food and social events.
- To enhance our event facilities, ICTC has completed the **renovation of the building 20 auditorium** to include an upgraded High Definition screen and new audio system.
- All 2022 undergraduate students who completed one semester at KFUPM have been reimbursed their 1000 SAR admission deposit.
- A **new Farm 5 supermarket** was opened by building 701, further improving on-campus facilities and, in particular, servicing the female accommodation buildings.
- Discussion ongoing to implement ideas from the KFUPM Rally, such as an annual international student competition at KFUPM, undergraduate research for majority students, the dual appointment of faculty to depts, co-hiring of faculty with a dual appointment, rotating chairmen between depts, chairman comes from a different dept, multidisciplinary graduate theses, courses in art, separate program for Al/cybersecurity, joint dept meetings (across colleges), micro-credentials, new org for student non-academic development, etc.
- KFUPM CPG Students won 1st place at the 14th Middle East Imperial Barrel Award Competition, advancing the team to represent the region in the international round.
- **IR4Lab, a startup initiated at the Entrepreneurship Institute** signed an MOU with Saudi Ground Services to implement a blockchain document solution at 28 Saudi airports.
- Interdepartmental meeting between PETE/Center for Integrative Petroleum Research and Chemistry **Dept.** was held with great attendance. Many commonalities were identified.
- 100 MHz NMR for structural elucidation was commissioned in B78, all are welcome to use it.
- Great visit from EXPEC ARC management to CPG. An overview of joint projects was delivered.
- The Communication System Week was organized by the EE Club and cosponsored by IRC-Communication Systems and Sensing. It included talks, workshops, and site visits for students.
