- The graduation ceremony took place last Thursday; 2450 students graduated, 1771 BS, 168
  MS, 36 Ph.D., and 475 MX, of which 69 were females. In addition, 861 undergraduate students earned high honors and were celebrated at a separate ceremony.
- The first **President's Medal** ceremony took place, in which **4** students were recognized for their achievements, and over 650 attendees came to enjoy the event activities.
- Student affairs conducted the first **Freshman gathering** to remind students of the necessary skills to success and university rules and regulations, 150 students attended.
- The President gave a talk to students on **Career Essentials**. Over 700 students attended the talk and were highly engaged during the talk and through the Q&A session.
- During **HRH Abdulaziz Bin Salman's** campus tour, he had a positive introduction to one of our first exchange students from the University of Houston.
- KBS is in talks with EY and Aramco to launch a **National Business Competition**. Students will compete to solve real projects and problems from EY, and winning participation will lead to employment at EY.
- A **delegation from Texas A&M** visited the university to collaborate on many topics, one of which is sending exchange students to KFUPM for a semester.
- KBS hosted talks with Mr. Abdulla Jum'ah, former CEO of Aramco, and HE Mohammed Al Sellemi, former Vice Minister of the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development.
- Mahmoud Desouky, a Ph.D. candidate in the Petroleum Engineering Department, won 1<sup>st</sup> place in the 2022 ARMA (American Rock Mechanics Association) international student research contest, which included the participation of researchers from 8 different countries and 14 highly ranked universities.
- Students from the Petroleum Engineering Department won 1<sup>st</sup> place in the SPWLA Saudi Chapter Paper Contest (BSc and Ph.D. Category) held in Saudi Aramco RDD. The winners will participate in the contest that will take place during the 64<sup>th</sup> SPWLA Annual Symposium in Texas, USA.
- The Department of Mathematics celebrated the **International Day of Mathematics (IDM)** on March 14<sup>th</sup>.
- The **5K Run for Health** took place on campus, which included the participation of more than 1,500 students, faculty members, university staff, and their families.
