- The Case Cracker Crew team of students achieved third place out of 50 teams in the Ahhil
  Consultathon competition in Riyadh, showcasing exceptional dedication and problemsolving skills.
- The SPE KFUPM Student Chapter has been awarded the Student Chapter Excellence Award
  for 2023. This prestigious award is the second-highest distinction attainable by a student
  chapter and is granted to up to 20% of student chapters worldwide.
- King Abdullah City for Atomic and Renewable Energy (KACARE) honored students of the CX
