- In a landmark achievement, Dr. Mousa Albashrawi has been recognized as the first
   Saudi researcher to be appointed as an associate editor in one of the most
   prestigious journals in the field of Information Systems: Communications of the
   Association for Information Systems (CAIS).
- The President welcomed **Dr. Jackie Y. Ying**, Director of the NanoBio Lab in Singapore and MIT's youngest-ever promoted to Professor at age 35. During her visit, she explored collaboration opportunities in bioengineering and energy applications. A highlight of the visit was her seminar on nanomaterials and their multifaceted applications.
- In an outstanding achievement, the team represented by four students from the KFUPM Geosciences Department earned 1st Place worldwide in AAPG's Imperial Barrel Award Program (IBA) 2023. They were awarded their trophy and gold medals in the Honors and Award Ceremony held in Houston, Texas.
- Dr. Mohammad Hammoudeh, Cybersecurity Chair Professor of the ICS Department,
  has been granted the prestigious Arab Researcher's Award by the Abdul Hameed
  Shoman Foundation for the 2023 session in the Technological and Agricultural
  Sciences category, Blockchain Technology & Applications field. This award

  contribute to advancing scientific and applied knowledge and resolving challenges
  in high-priority local, regional, and global areas.
